5. Interestingly, the strawberry is the only fruit whose seeds are on the outside rather than the inside of the fruit.



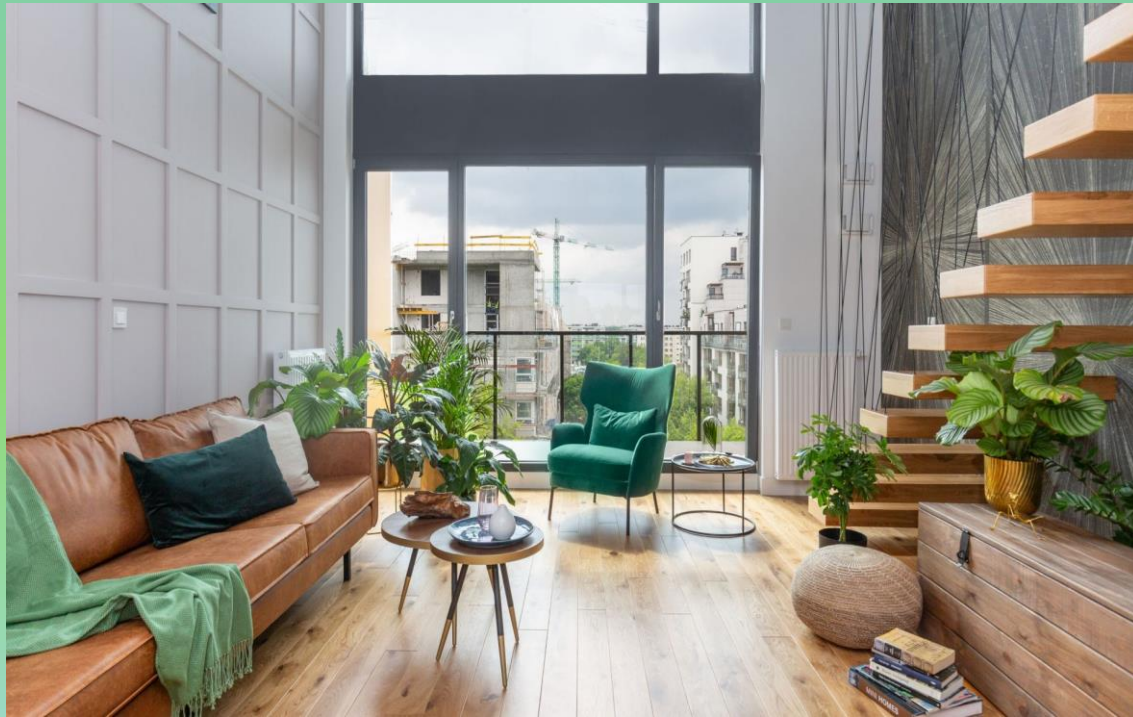
6. The smell of freshly cut grass has stress-reducing properties. Well, unless the mower broke down 😊

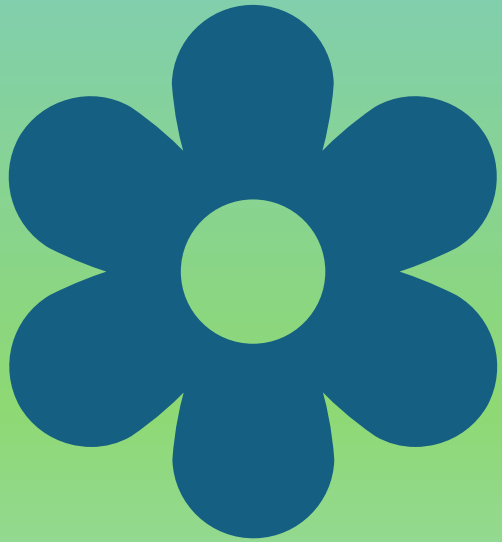




## Did you know what the symbol of sunflower is?
